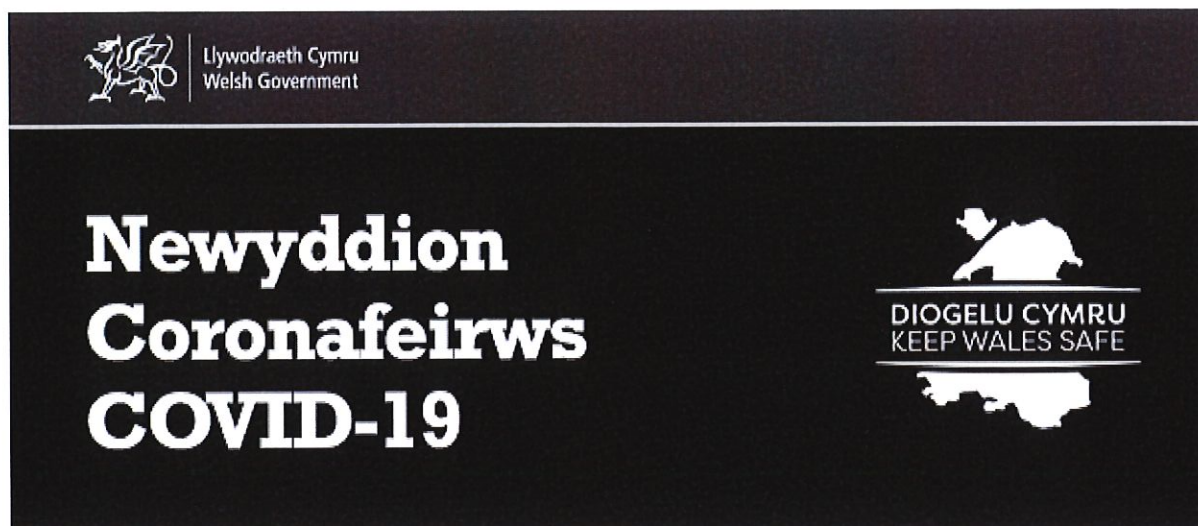

Further restrict social meeting and force face coverings to help prevent new coronavirus crisis

It will be mandatory for people to wear face coverings in indoor public places in Wales from Monday as rules are tightened to prevent a new coronavirus crisis.

Local restrictions to the management of the Coronavirus in Caerphilly County

Coronavirus rules will be tightened across Caerphilly County Borough to stop the spread of the coronavirus locally, Health Minister Vaughan Gething said tonight.

£2.3m to provide face coverings for secondary school and further education learners

The Welsh Government has committed over £2.3m to provide free face coverings for all learners in secondary schools and further education settings.
