

Buckley Fireworks Display 2021

With the introduction on Monday 11th October 2021 of the new Welsh Government Regulations in relation to organised events, it was announced that “The law is changing today so all adults over -18 will need to show an NHS Covid pass or a negative COVID-19 test to enter certain premises.”. One of the four listed premises is “outdoor non-seated events for more than 4,000 people.

In consideration of the above, the Town Council has reluctantly and sadly decided that the Annual Firework Display due to be held on 7th November 2021 on Higher Common will have to be cancelled. The reasons for the decision are that it is not feasible for all those eligible people attending the Firework Display to be requested to provide the necessary evidence in respect of the NHS Covid pass or a negative COVID-19 test. Where the Firework Display is held, it is impossible for the Town Council to comply with the new Regulations. The 360 degree access to the event makes it impossible to meet the criteria required.

The Town Council has taken this decision following the new Regulations as it cannot comply with them in order for this free event to achieve the safety of the community, volunteers, supporters and the public in this case.

Buckley Town Council hopes the public appreciate that this decision had to be made to comply with the new Covid Regulations.
