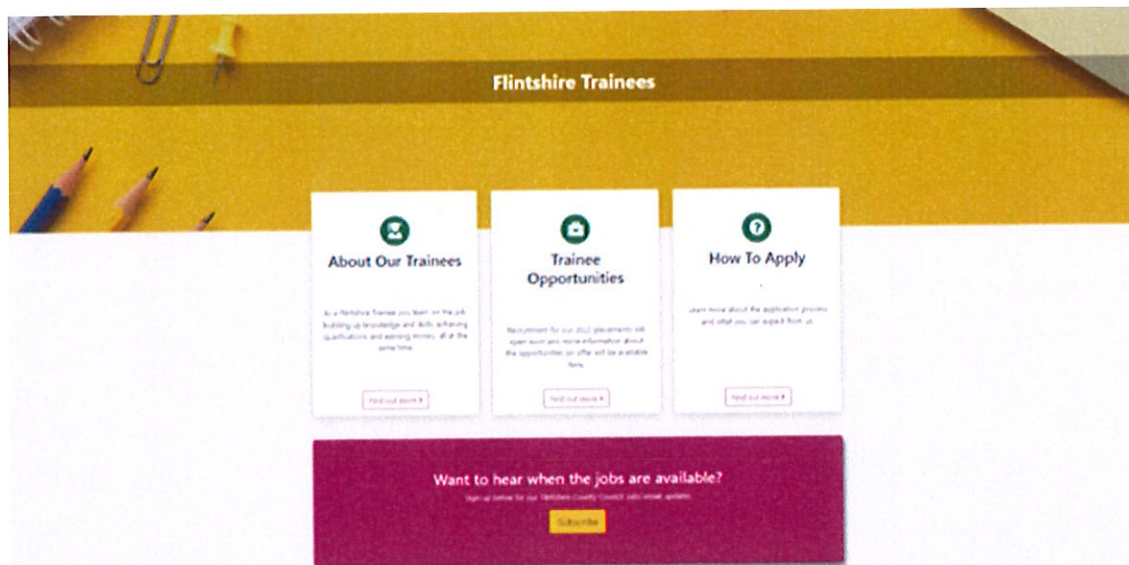
The campaign will also promote the safe and positive use of digital channels when communicating with Council services.

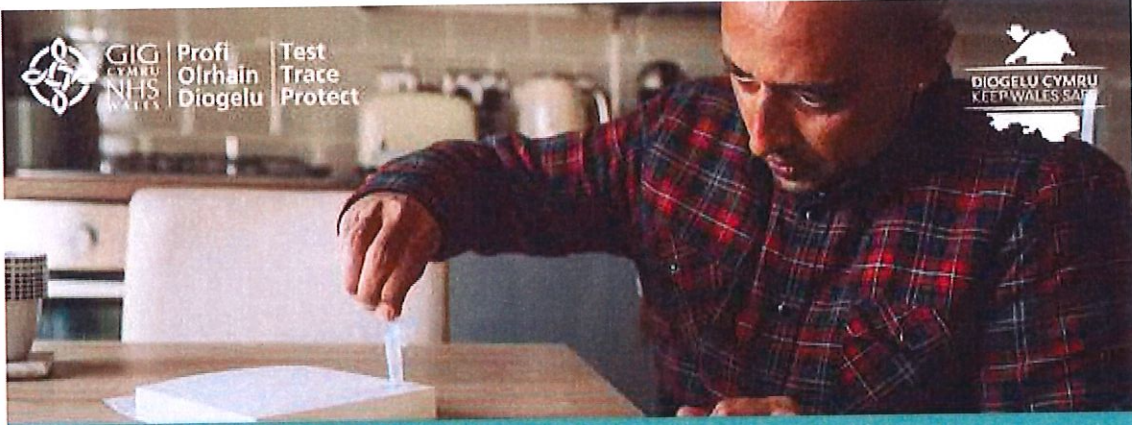


Have you had COVID over the past month or two?

How the five-day isolation rule works

Llywodraeth Cymru

Self-isolate from day 1 to day 5

From day 6 to day 9 you can end self-isolation if you test negative on two consecutive days

Day	0	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
	Your symptoms begin or you test positive					Start home testing with lateral flow tests					Isolation ends as long as you feel well and don't have a temperature
