BUCKLEY TOWN COUNCIL BURSARY SCHEME

PURPOSE OF BURSARY SCHEME:

To recognise and support a small number of individuals each year by awarding a Bursary of up to £500.00 per annum to each successful applicant. The Bursary will be in the form of financial assistance towards tuition fees charged by the Institution the successful applicant(s) is/are due to or already attending and will be paid direct to the successful student(s).

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE BURSARY:

Any applicant(s) must live in the geographic boundaries of Buckley Town Council and must be about to or already attending a University or College of Higher Education.

DURATION OF THE BURSARY:

Each Bursary shall be for a period of three years. However, should circumstances dictate that the recipient's course is for a longer period, then each request for an extension to the Bursary will be assessed on its own merits.

CRITERIA REQUIRED BY APPLICANTS FOR THE BURSARY:

Applicants for the Bursary will be judged on the following criteria:

- a) The contribution they have or continue to provide to improving the social and/or cultural life of the Town of Buckley.
- or b) The support the applicant(s) has or continues to give to Youth Movements and/or Senior Citizens in the Town of Buckley
- or c) Any other demonstrable contribution the applicant(s) has made or continues to make to enriching the environment and well being of and for the benefit of, the people of Buckley.

APPLICATIONS AND JUDGING:

Application will be by written CV with the support of at least two references together with supporting evidence of contributions made to the town and its residents. Completed application documentation should be forwarded to Buckley Town Council, Council Offices, Mold Road, Buckley, CH7 2JB by 30th September each year.

Applications will be judged by a Panel appointed by Buckley Town Council and the successful applicant(s) notified.

Each applicant(s) must provide the name, address and contact details of the University or College of Higher Education they intend to or are already attending, with their submitted documentation in support of their application for the Bursary.
