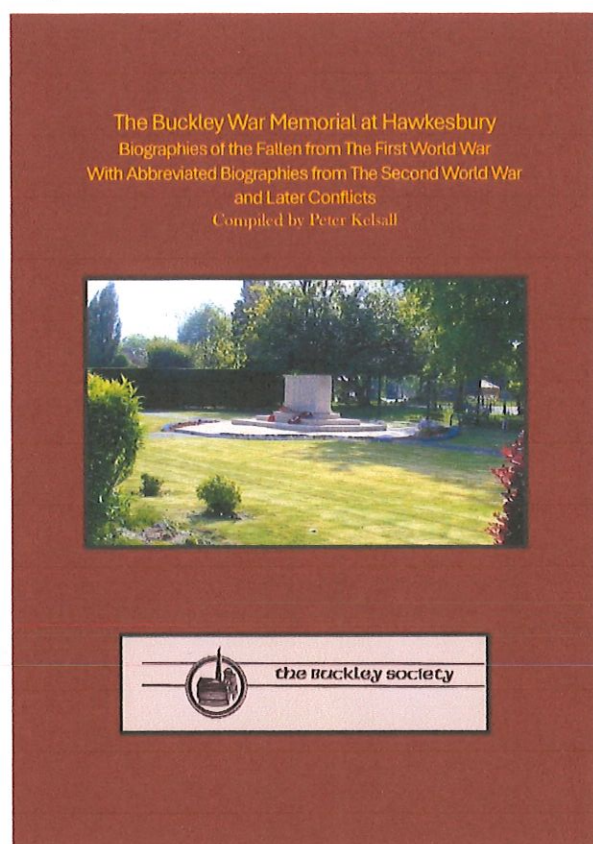

Preface by Peter Kelsall

This book presents biographies to commemorate 202 men and one woman whose names are inscribed on the Hawkesbury Memorial in Buckley, Flintshire (139 from WW1, 62 from WW2 and two from later conflicts). For the WW1 casualties, each biography is limited to one page for reasons of equality (just as the same simple headstone is used for all Commonwealth War Graves Commission graves). We have included photographs of the men and

graves where available, or at least a photograph of the cemetery where they were laid to rest or the memorial where they are commemorated.

Abbreviated biographies are provided for WW2 and later names which to date have not been researched to the same degree.
